What: Travel on pilgrimage to Wontulp-Bi-Buya college, Cairns, to participate in the Theology teaching block. This pilgrimage offers theological students and ordinands the opportunity to: Listen to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander theological and social perspectives, and to learn from these perspectives to gain a more holistic Australian theological perspective on theology and ministry.

- Explore what mission means in a 21st Century post-colonial church.
- Worship and pray together
- Build relationships that will enhance mutual ministry and theological learning.
- Increase cultural awareness and the challenges faced by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander theological students and their churches and communities.
