

TAX APPEAL 2026 AND 'MATCHED FUNDING'

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. WHAT IS THE TAX APPEAL 2026 AND HOW DOES IT WORK?

Tax Appeal 2026 is ABM Anglicans in Development's end of financial year/tax-time campaign. We are using this campaign as an opportunity to raise the funds needed to access additional financial support from the Australian Government through the Australian NGO Cooperation Program (ANCP). Additionally, all donations are tax-deductible.

2. WILL MY GIFT BE MATCHED?

Your gift to our Tax Appeal will be combined with generous but limited funding from the Australian Government. As one of approximately 60 trusted and accredited charities, each year a number of our projects are supported by the Australian Government through the Australian NGO Cooperation Program (ANCP). To access this additional funding, ABM Anglicans in Development must raise \$1 for every \$5 received from the Australian Government. However, donations must be made by 30 June 2026 to help us unlock funding from the Australian Government for the following financial year.

3. HOW LONG IS THE APPEAL GOING FOR?

Donations to the Tax Appeal 2026 will be open until 30 June 2026. All donations must be received before the end of the financial year, so that donations can be part of our submission to access funding from the Australian Government. Your donation before 30 June 2026 will help more people escape poverty now and in future years. Donations made after June 30 2026 can still be accepted, but will then be applied to the next financial year.

4. WHO IS DFAT OR WHO GIVES YOU THE MONEY?

DFAT is the Australian Government's Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade. ABM Anglicans in Development is one of approximately 60 Australian organisations who receive support from the Australian Government through the Australian NGO Cooperation Program (ANCP) to implement community development and poverty alleviation programs overseas. An additional benefit of our partnership with the Australian Government is that we are accountable for using this funding to deliver high quality, effective and sustainable programs that follow sector best-practice standards.

5. WHAT COUNTRIES RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH MY GIFT TO THE TAX APPEAL 2026?

Your donation to the Tax Appeal 2026 will be combined with government funds and invested in specific community development projects, maximising the impact of your gift. Our current projects funded through the Tax Appeal 2026 are in the Philippines, Kenya, Zambia and Vanuatu. We work in collaboration with Anglican Church Partners around the world to help deliver community-driven development. We believe that local communities are best-placed to know what programs they want and what assistance they need from our partners.
